

# Death of Veteran Durban Revisionist Leader

THE JEWISH HERALD deeply regrets to record the death in Durban last week of Mr. Hayman Levy, a veteran leader of the Zionist Revisionist Organisation, the one-time Chairman of the Organisation's Branch in Port Elizabeth and Durban, and for a short period the General Secretary of the Organisation.

He is survived by his wife Rae, (his first wife Queenie died 17 years ago), his son Anthony and daughter-in-law Doreen in Israel and their three children, and his daughter Fern Levy in London.
